
2) Bilateral Meetings (call)

Future eligible applicants for grants under main open calls, who are interested in a project implemented in bilateral cooperation with donor project partners, are entitled to arrange partnership cooperation through bilateral meetings.

For this purpose, it is possible to use:

- travel from the Czech Republic to donor states to meet with potential partners
- travel of potential partners from donor states to the Czech Republic to meet with Czech applicants

Opened 2 months before the main open call



3) Active promotion

Valuable cooperation with DPPs

- Information Seminar in Oslo, Norway (14.2.2019)
- Match-making seminar for cultural heritage (April 2019)
- Tips on website

For arranging good partnership and cooperation in project, it is important to:

- Share the same goal and vision
- Share understanding of the content and strategy of the project
- Agree on concrete involvement of partner in project activities
- Agree on partner's budget including financial flows
- Have long-term perspective
- Establish personal contact (ideally meeting in person)
